



## Environmental, Health, & Safety (EHS) Policy

*Carestream Health will conduct business in such a way as to preserve the environment and protect the health and safety of the company's associates, neighbors and customers while providing solutions that dramatically improve the quality and cost of healthcare.*

### EHS Policy Implementation:

All directors, officers, and associates have an obligation for making “ē·co·pride” decisions which foster sustainable development. These decisions are based on the elements set forth in this policy, and can be thought of as embodying “ē·co·pride”:

Environmental and Employee Considerations that are combined with Compliance and Cost Considerations resulting in Proper and Justified Decisions.

#### ē·co·pride:

- Environmental preservation – the company will use life cycle thinking in product development and in manufacturing design to prevent incidents and conserve natural resources. Life cycle thinking will be promoted as a means of creating practical design solutions and establishing governing requirements.
- Employee health & safety – the company will create a workplace that protects its associates and strives for zero injuries.

#### ē·co·pride:

- Compliance expectation – the company will work with suppliers and development teams to provide products in accordance with company standards, and with applicable laws and regulatory requirements. All sites will be operated to ensure compliance with local and national legislation. Carestream Health will continue to evaluate ways to improve its environmental profile beyond compliance limits where feasible.
- Cost effective solutions – the company will apply lean thinking to reduce and eliminate waste from operations, to prevent capital loss, and to maintain an efficient EHS management program.

#### ē·co·pride:

- Embrace – the company will embrace a culture where associates can be proud of the company's decisions, ethical behavior, and progress.
- Integrate – the company will integrate EHS initiatives seamlessly with business goals and objectives consistent with EHS Policy and corporate values.
- Demonstrate – the company will demonstrate management commitment by measuring and reporting on performance.
